I. Presentation for Basic Research Slide Deck (5-7 slides only):

A. Context and Rationale:

Clearly state the research topic and its significance.
Provide a brief overview of the research objectives and methodology.
Introduce the key research questions or hypotheses.

B. Research Questions

Present the research questions of the study.
Research questions should clearly state what the writer needs to do.

C. Methodology:

Describe the research design (e.g., experimental, survey, case study).
Explain the data collection methods and procedures.
Discuss the data analysis techniques used.

D. Results and Discussion:

- Present the key findings of your research such as charts, graphs to illustrate your results.
- Interpret the findings in relation to your research questions or hypotheses.
- Discuss the implications of your findings.

E. Conclusions and Recommendations:

- Summarize the main points of your presentation.
- Reiterate the significance of your research.
- Offer recommendations for future research.

II. Presentation Format for Action Research (5-7 slides only):

A. Context and Rationale:

Clearly state the research topic and its significance.
Introduce the key research objectives and research questions or hypotheses.

B. Innovation, Intervention, and Strategy

Clearly describe the innovation, intervention and strategy.
Discuss the importance on the use of innovation, intervention and strategy.

C. Action Research Questions

Present the research questions of the study.
Research questions should clearly state what the writer needs to do.

D. Action Research Methods:

Describe the research design, data collection methods and procedures.
